Resolution approving Public Utilities Commission's continuation of Agreement No. CS-524, Program Management Services, with the Water Infrastructure Partners (WIP) for a third year through February 28, 2003.

WHEREAS, With the approval of the Board of Supervisors (Board Resolution #754-00), the City, acting through its Public Utilities Commission, on October 4, 2000 entered into a professional services contract with the San Francisco Water Alliance ("SFWA"), a joint venture of Bechtel Infrastructure Corporation (a subsidiary of the Bechtel Corporation), Primus Industries, Inc. (formerly The Jefferson Company), and Jacobs Civil, Inc., a subsidiary of Jacobs Engineering Group (formerly Sverdrup Civil, Inc.) for program management services to support the SFPUC's water, power and sewer capital improvement program, CS-524, Program Management Services, ("Program Management Contract"); and

WHEREAS, On May 7, 2002, the PUC approved Bechtel Infrastructure Corporation's request to withdraw from the SFWA, and simultaneously approved the assignment of the remainder of the Program Management Contract to the Water Infrastructure Partners (WIP), a joint venture of the remaining SFWA partners, Primus Industries, Inc. and Jacobs Civil, Inc. (Resolution No. 02-0079); and,

WHEREAS, On June 28, 2002, the Board approved the assignment of the Program Management Contract to the WIP, a joint venture of Primus Industries, Inc., and Jacobs Civil, Inc.; and,

WHEREAS, By its terms, the continuation of the Program Management Contract is subject to approval by the San Francisco Board of Supervisors on an annual basis; and

WHEREAS, The cost of services under the Program Management Contract is not to exceed \$45 million over four years, and not to exceed \$12 million for services provided during the third year of the contract; and

WHEREAS, The PUC is separately submitting a request for supplemental appropriation of \$7 million to fund the third year of the Program Management Contract of which \$6 million will be allocated to Program Management Office, and \$1 million will be allocated for SFPUC overhead, including staffing, insurance, equipment, and audit costs; and

WHEREAS, The Human Rights Commission established initial goals of 30% MBE and 10% WBE subconsultant participation for the Program Management Contract, which goals would increase by 2% MBE and 1% for each subsequent year such that the HRC goals for Year 3 are 34% MBE and 12% WBE; and

WHEREAS, The WIP has met or exceeded the performance measures set for the second year; and

WHEREAS, The HRC has confirmed that the Water Infrastructure Partners are in compliance with the San Francisco Administrative Code Chapter 12B, Equal Benefits requirement; and

WHEREAS, On August 27, 2002, the PUC by resolution (Resolution No. 02-0180); approved a three-month time extension for the performance of Year 2 work under the Program Management Contract,;

WHEREAS, On December 18, 2002, the PUC by resolution (Resolution No. 02-0269) approved the continuation of the Program Management Contract for Year 3 commencing on December 22, 2002; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board hereby approves the continuation of Agreement No. CS-524 Program Management Services, with the Water Infrastructure Partners (WIP) for program management services for a third year through February 28, 2003.
