All Advertisements For Bids for public works under this Chapter shall specify that for any asphalt to be used in a City and County of San Francisco public work project, contractors and subcontractors shall obtain purchase such asphalt from the City and County of San Francisco asphalt plant. Failure of the requirement to appear in the Advertisement For Bids shall not abrogate the requirement that contractors and subcontractors procure the asphalt for public work projects from the City and County of San Francisco asphalt plant. The Director of Public Works or his or her designee A bidder or contractor may be excused a bidder or contractor from this requirement by the Director of Public Works or his or her designee upon a showing by the bidder or contractor that either (a) the City and County of San Francisco

asphalt plant would be unable to provide the necessary quantity of asphalt at the time
