RESOLUTION NO. 740-99

(AIRPORT GRANT - FEDERAL FUNDS)

AUTHORIZING AIRPORT COMMISSION TO ACCEPT AND EXPEND A FUNDING INCREASE FROM \$708,000 TO \$1,202,500 FROM THE FEDERAL AVIATION ADMINISTRATION FOR THE K-9 EXPLOSIVES DETECTION PROGRAM ; PLACING \$182,000 ON RESERVE.

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3 WHEREAS, the Airport utilizes canine ("K-9") animals to detect explosives at the Airport; and

4 WHEREAS, the SFPD-Airport Bureau K-9 Explosives Detection Team responds to bomb
5 threats at other Bay Area airports and other municipalities; and

6 WHEREAS, the SFPD-Airport Bureau K-9 Explosives Detection Team Program incurs
7 expenses for handler salaries, handler overtime, handler uniforms (laundry), K-9 food, K-9 veterinary
8 care (medications), K-9 kenneling, vehicles, vehicle care and maintenance, handler training/travel, and
9 explosive training/travel; and

10 WHEREAS, Airport staff has signed a modified Cooperative Agreement with the Federal
11 Aviation Administration ("FAA") office of Civil Aviation Security Operations providing for
12 reimbursement for the SFPD-Airport Bureau K-9 Explosives Detection Team Program expenses
13 incurred during the time period March 27, 1998 to September 30, 1998; and


14 WHEREAS, the Airport received notification from other FAA of two additional increases
15 totaling \$494,500 of service reimbursement from October 1, 1998 and thereafter, which will bring the
16 total service reimbursement \$1,202,500; now, therefore, be it


17 RESOLVED, that this Board of Supervisors does hereby authorize the Airport to accept and
18 expend this FAA funding increase for the SFPD-Airport Bureau K-9 Explosives Detection Team
19 Program; and, be it

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20 FURTHER RESOLVED, That funds in the amount of \$182,000 are hereby placed on
21 reserve pending submission of budget details for the Federal FY 1997-98 FAA grant,
22 to be released by the Finance and Labor Committee.

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
