9	WHEREAS, The purpose of the Safe Havens program is to enhance and increase the		
10	availability of existing community resources for the safe visitation and exchange of children for		
11	divorced or separated families in which domestic violence, child abuse, sexual assault or		
12	stalking is present; and,		
13	WHEREAS, The Safe Havens grant of \$350,000 from the Violence Against Women		
14	Office for the two-year period October 1, 2002 through September 30, 2004 will be		
15	administered by the SafeStart Initiative of the Department of Children, Youth, & Their		
16	Families; and,		
17	WHEREAS, The City has previously accepted a federal grant for the SafeStart Initiative		
18	to reduce the incidence and impact of violence on families with young children through service		
19	delivery, systems change, and policy development; and,		
20	WHEREAS, The Safe Havens program represents another step in developing the		
21	unique partnership between the City and County of San Francisco and the federal		
22	government in creating a comprehensive and community-based effort to combat domestic,		
23	family, and intimate partner violence which includes funding for Rally Family Visitation

2	WHEREAS, The funds will be used to enhance and expand services at Rally Family		
3	Visitation Services of St. Francis Memorial Hospital for safe visitation and exchange of		
4	children by and between custodial and non-custodial parents with a history of domestic		
5	violence, child abuse, sexual assault, or stalking, except children in foster care, kinship care,		
6	or protective custody of courts or social service agencies; and,		
7	WHEREAS, The Department proposes to maximize the use of available grant funds of		
8	program expenditures by not including indirect costs in the grant budget; now, therefore, be it		
9	RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of indirect costs in		
10	the grant budget; and be it		
11	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the \$350,000 from the Violence Against Women Office		
12	will be the only allocation of funds; and be it		
13	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the City and County of San Francisco will contract with		
14	Rally Family Visitation Services of St. Francis Memorial Hospital for provision of Safe Havens		
15	program services; and be it
