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6 WHEREAS, A Consolidated Municipal Election was conducted in the City and County
7 of San Francisco on Tuesday, November 5, 2019, which placed before the electorate
8 candidates for Mayor, Board of Supervisors, City Attorney, District Attorney, Public Defender,
9 Sheriff, Treasurer, Governing Board of the San Francisco Unified School District, and
10 Governing Board of the Community College District; and local ballot measures; and

11 WHEREAS, John Arntz, the Director of Elections for the City and County of San
12 Francisco, has certified the results of the Consolidated Municipal Election, a copy of which is
13 contained in Board File No. 191225, and which is incorporated herein by reference; now,
