

- 1. Sales of alcoholic beverages shall be permitted between the hours of 8:00 am to 11:00 pm each day of the week.
- 2. No person under the age of 21 shall sell or deliver alcoholic beverages. .
- 3. No pre-package beer or malt beverages shall not be sold as single unit
- 4. No wine shall be sold with an alcoholic content of great than 15% by volume except for "Dinner Wines" which have been aged two years or more and maintained in corded bottles.
- 5. No distilled spirits shall be sold in bottles or containers smaller than 600ml.

- 6. Beer, malt beverages, and wine coolers in containers of 16 oz or less cannot be sold by single containers, but must be sold in manufacturer pre-packaged multi-unit quantities.
- 7. The sale, service and consumption of powdered alcohol or like non-liquid alcoholic beverage based product is prohibited




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
