Subject: Poll Results for Outside Boards and Commissions

On July 17, 2019, a memo was sent to all Members of the Board of Supervisors, surveying their interest in serving the vacant Seats to outside boards and commissions.

Analysis:

The below nominations are based upon current Seats held and seniority, pursuant to Board Rules 6.2 and 6.5:

- **Association of Bay Area Government** - Supervisor Mandelman expressed interest in being reappointed to Seat 1 and Supervisor Mar expressed interest in being appointed to Seat 2. The remaining Seats 3, 4 and 6 will remain vacant. Therefore, we will forward the nominations of Supervisors Mandelman and Mar to the Rules Committee.
- **Bay Area Air Quality Management District** - Supervisor Walton expressed interest in Seat 1; therefore, we will forward the nomination of Supervisor Walton to the Rules Committee.
- **California State Association of Counties (CSAC)** - All Supervisors declined the opportunity or were unresponsive to the appointment to Seats 1 and 2; therefore, CSAC will not have Board representation.
- **Children and Families First Commission** - All Supervisors declined the opportunity or were unresponsive to the appointment to Seat 1; therefore, Children and Families First Commission will not have Board representation.
- **Local Agency Formation Commission** - All Supervisors declined the opportunity or were unresponsive to the appointment to Seats 1 and 5 on the Local Agency Formation Commission.
- **Urban Counties Caucus** - All Supervisors declined the opportunity or were unresponsive to the appointment to Seat 1; therefore, the caucus will not have Board representation.
- **San Francisco Int' l Airport Community Roundtable** - All Supervisors declined the opportunity or were unresponsive to the appointment to the alternate Seat 2.

For all the remaining vacancies, we will poll again in the Fall.

Board Qualifications:

The Association of Bay Area Governments Executive Board consists of a membership of a maximum of 38 voting members (representatives and ex officio members). The Board of Supervisors appoints two of its members as representatives and two of its members as alternates. In addition, in even numbered years not evenly divisible by four the Board appoints one of its members to a two-year term.

The composition of the San Francisco City and County members are as follows: The Mayor and one other elective officer or member of the Mayor's staff of the City and County appointed by the Mayor; two representatives of the City and County appointed by the Board of Supervisors, and a fifth representative to be appointed alternately by the Mayor and the Board of Supervisors, with two-year appointments beginning in years evenly divisible by four to be made by the Mayor and with two-year appointments made in even-numbered years not evenly divisible by four to be made by the Board of Supervisors. Appointments shall become effective on July 1.

The association is organized for the purposes of establishing a permanent forum for discussion and study of regional and subregional problems of interest and concern to the counties and cities of the San Francisco Bay Area, developing policies and actions, and providing services and undertaking actions addressing such problems. The Executive Board's duties are outlined in the ABAG Bylaws.
