Modification No. 4

THIS MODIFICATION (this "Modification") is dated August 15, 2023, in San Francisco, California, by and between **Dignity Health dba St. Mary's Medical Center** ("Contractor"), and the City and County of San Francisco, a municipal corporation ("City"), acting by and through its Airport Commission, hereinafter referred to as "**Commission**."

RECITALS

- A. City and Contractor have entered into the Agreement to provide urgent care; emergency medicine; occupational medicine; travel medicine; pre-placement examinations; and clinical care for City and tenant employees, contractors, and the traveling public; and
- B. On February 19, 2019, by Resolution No. 19-0026, the Commission awarded this Agreement to the Contractor for the initial term of July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2022, in a not-to-exceed amount of \$5,900,000; and
- C. On May 28, 2020, the Airport Director administratively modified the Agreement (Modification No. 1) to add Dignity Health Medical Foundation (DHMF) as a subcontractor to the Agreement to make available onsite testing for diagnosis of COVID-19 for Airport Commission employees, and for employees of Airport tenants, Airlines and other entities that provide services at SFO; and
- D. On May 18, 2021, by Resolution No. 21-0116, the Commission approved Modification No. 2 to increase the not-to-exceed amount for the initial term of the Agreement to \$9,400,000, and to reduce the fixed management fee established in the Agreement by 50% for fiscal years 2020-2021 and 2021-2022; and
- E. On April 19, 2022, by Resolution No. 22-0062, the Commission approved Modification No. 3 to exercise the option to extend the term for two years to June 30, 2024 and increase the not-to-exceed amount for the Agreement to \$11,000,000, and to reduce the Clinic's Monday-to-Friday operating hours from 12 to 8 hours for fiscal years 2022-2023 and 2023-2024; and
- F. On June 7, 2022, by Resolution No. 269-22, the Board of Supervisors approved Modification No. 3 under San Francisco Charter Section 9.118; and
- G. On August 15, 2023, by Resolution No. 23-0201, the Commission approved Modification No. 4 to increase the not-to-exceed amount to \$12,700,000; and
- H. On , by Resolution No. , the Board of Supervisors approved Modification No. 4 under San Francisco Charter Section 9.118; and
- I. There is no Local Business Entity ("LBE") subcontracting participation requirement for this Agreement; and
- J. Approval for this Agreement was obtained when the Civil Service Commission approved PSC No. 44548-16/17 on April 18, 2022.

NOW, THEREFORE, Contractor and the City agree as follows:

- 1. Article 1. Definitions, Section 1.1 Agreement means the contract document dated July 1, 2019, Modification No. 1, dated May 28, 2020, Modification No. 2, dated April 19, 2022, Modification No. 3, dated May 18, 2021, including all attached appendices, and all applicable city ordinances and "Mandatory City Requirements" which are specifically incorporated by reference into the Agreement.
- **2. Article 3. Financial Matters, Section 3.3. Compensation, 3.3.1 Payment** is hereby amended to increase the total compensation by \$1,700,000 for a new total not-to-exceed amount of \$12,700,000.
- 3. **Appendix** C is hereby replaced in its entirety with the new **Appendix** C-1: **Financial Projections, Five-Year Budget.**
