4 WHEREAS, the City and County of San Francisco encourages collaborative projects because of
5 their high success rate for at risk populations affected by welfare reform; and

6 WHEREAS, the Families in Transition Program is a collaborative project led by Mission
7 Neighborhood Centers and incorporating three other non-profit entities, Mission Language and Vocational
8 School, Mission Day Care/Catholic Youth Organization, and Instituto Familiar de la Raza, providing job
9 training, child care and family support services respectively; and

10 WHEREAS, the Families in Transition Program will provide welfare to work services in
11 communities with a high concentration of previous Temporary Assistance to Needy Families' (TANF)
12 recipients, the Inner Mission, the Outer Mission and the South of Market; and

13 WHEREAS, the Collaborative introduces both an innovative leadership structure and an creative
14 system for service delivery based on a continuum of care model that is both culturally sensitive and strong
15 in its potential results to place TANF recipients in well paying jobs; now, therefore, be it

16 RESOLVED, that the San Francisco Board of Supervisors recognizes the outstanding work of the
17 Mission Neighborhood Centers, Mission Language and Vocational School, Mission Day Care/Catholic
18 Youth Organization, and Instituto Familiar de la Raza and the importance of the Families in Transition
