Resolution enacting and rescinding traffic regulations on various streets.

RESOLVED, That, in accordance with the provisions of the California Vehicle Code and the San Francisco Traffic Code, the following regulations governing the movement of vehicles are hereby enacted or rescinded as designated below:

RIGHT TURN ONLY ONTO CARTER STREET - ESTABLISH

Walbridge Street, eastbound onto Carter Street

NO TURN ON RED - RESCIND

Geneva Avenue, eastbound, at Carter Avenue and Walbridge Street

ONE-WAY STREET - ESTABLISH

Florentine Street, southbound (uphill), from Mission Street to Brunswick Street.

LEFT LANE MUST TURN LEFT - ESTABLISH

Buchanan Street, northbound, at Hermann Street

Categorically exempt from Environmental Review Class 1(c)(9) changes in the traffic and parking regulations where such changes do not establish a higher speed limit or result in more than a negligible increase in the use of the street.


