15	reasonable charge for the returned check not to exceed twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) for the first	
16	check and thirty-five dollars (\$35.00) for each subsequent check may be imposed on the person	
17	who issued the check by the Treasurer of the City and County, as well as any other penalties	
18	authorized under California Civil Code Section 1719. This charge may be added to and	
19	become part of any underlying obligation other than an obligation which constitutes a lien on	
20	real property; and a different method of payment of that payment and future payments by the
