7 WHEREAS, The San Francisco Unified School District (SFUSD) recently announced  
8 school placements for the 2007-2008 school year, and;

9 WHEREAS, The number of students placed at Guadalupe Elementary School exceeds  
10 capacity by 40 students, and;

11 WHEREAS, To accommodate these additional students, the SFUSD has proposed  
12 eliminating the school's state of the art computer lab and converting it into a classroom, and;

13 WHEREAS, Computer skills are an essential element of a comprehensive education  
14 that prepares students for the modern world, and;

15 WHEREAS, The City identified District 11 as the potential initial roll out site for free  
16 Wi-Fi service, and;

17 WHEREAS, This decision was based upon the positive impact technology can play in  
18 improving the lives of children and minorities and the high concentration of these groups in  
19 District 11, and;

20 WHEREAS, During the 2005-2006 school year, over 95 percent of the students  
21 enrolled at Guadalupe were minorities, and;

22 WHEREAS, Eliminating the school's computer lab will counteract the City's efforts to  
23 bridge the digital divide and hinder the development of the school's students; now, therefore,
