- D. By letter dated December 29, 1998, a copy of which is on file in the office of the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No. 990247, the Planning Department found that the proposed street vacation is in conformity with the City's General Plan and with the Eight Priority Policies of Planning Code §101.1. The San Francisco Board of Supervisors adopts as its own and incorporates by reference herein as though fully set forth, the findings in the Planning Department's letter described above.
- E. The Board of Supervisors finds under Section 8334 of the California Streets and Highways Code that the portions of Hickory Street to be vacated are excess rights-of-way no longer required for street or highway purposes.
- F. The Board of Supervisors also finds under Section 8334.5 of the California Streets and Highways Code that no in-place public utility facilities exist in the portions of Hickory Street that will be affected by the vacation.

Section 2. Under the provisions of the Public Streets, Highways, and Service Easement Vacation Law, Sections 8330 through 8336 of the California Street and Highways Code, the Board of Supervisors hereby orders the summary vacation of the portions of Hickory Street shown on the attached drawing. As of the date of recordation of this Ordinance, those portions of Hickory Street described in the drawing will no longer constitute a public street or highway.

Section 3. The Board of Supervisors hereby directs the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors to transmit to the Recorder, the Director of Public Works, and the Director of Property, a certified copy of this Ordinance, and the Board of Supervisors further directs such officials to proceed thereafter as required by law.
