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7	WHEREAS, The Human Services Agency provides food stamps to eligible San
	Francisco residents; and,
8	WHEREAS, Eligible recipients (Able Bodied Adults without Dependents – ABAWDS) of
9	food stamp benefits are limited to receiving the benefit for three months within a three year
0	period of time for able bodied adults who are not working, participating in a work program for
1	20 hours or more each week, or in workfare; and,
2	WHEREAS, The State of California can issue waivers to counties, including San
3	Francisco, that would allow Human Services Agency to continue to issue food stamps to
4	ABAWDS beyond the three months within a three year time period; and,
5	WHEREAS, The State of California can issue the aforementioned waivers for either the
6	entire county or part of the county based upon having a local unemployment rate in excess of
7	10%, or in excess of 20% of the national unemployment rate; and,
8	WHEREAS, San Francisco County has sub-county areas that have consistently had
9	local unemployment rates in excess of 10% and/or 20% above the national unemployment
20	rate; and,
21	WHEREAS, High unemployment rates make it increasingly more difficult for individuals
22	to obtain and maintain employment within their own community; now, therefore, be it
23	RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors authorizes the Human Services Agency to
24	request consideration for an ABAWD waiver for the period of March 1, 2005 through March 1,

1	2006 through the State of California to continue to provide food stamp benefits to individuals
2	that reside within a sub-county area that has had a consistently high local unemployment rate
3	in excess of 10% or 20% above the national unemployment rate average; and be it
4	FURTHER RESOLVED, That a copy of this resolution be forwarded to his Honor, the
5	Mayor, with a request that he transmit a copy to the, Deputy Director - Welfare to Work
6	Division of the State of California's Department of Social Services with a request that they
7	take all action necessary to achieve the objectives of this resolution.
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
