9 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

10 Section 1. The San Francisco Administrative Code is hereby amended by adding  
11 Section 2A.86, to read as follows:

12 Sec. 2A.86 POLICE: 10 MOST WANTED SUSPECTS CRIME BULLETIN.

13 The San Francisco Police Department shall issue and post a 10 Most Wanted  
14 Suspects Crime Bulletin. This bulletin shall be kept current and updated by the Police  
15 Department each time a change occurs to the list. It shall include the posted date and an  
16 anonymous tip telephone number for the public to call. The bulletin shall be posted by the  
17 Police Department on the San Francisco Police Department’s website and City-owned and/or  
18 City-operated property including, but not limited to, libraries, recreation centers, community  
19 centers, hospitals, health clinics, senior centers, police stations, fire stations, garages, court  
20 buildings, City Hall, homeless centers, cultural centers, and MUNI stations.
