

1 [Accept-Expend State Grant]

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3 Resolution authorizing the Chief of Police for the City and County of
4 San Francisco to retroactively accept and expend a grant in the
5 amount of \$330,000.00 from the Governor's Office of Emergency
6 Services for a project entitled "California Multi-Jurisdictional
7 Methamphetamine Enforcement Team (Cal-MMET)" program.

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9 WHEREAS, The Chief of Police for the City and County of San
10 Francisco desires to undertake a certain project designated Cal-MMET,
11 to be funded from funds made available through Governor's Office of
12 Emergency Services; and,

13 WHEREAS, Law enforcement efforts will disrupt and interdict the
14 distribution channels for methamphetamine coming into the county and
15 San Francisco Airport, identify mid-level methamphetamine dealers,
16 identification and destruction of methamphetamine labs, focus on the
17 well-being of children, increase child endangerment referrals for
18 prosecution, increase counties health prevention efforts related to
19 HIV and methamphetamine, and augment resources and add efficiency to
20 our existing County's Crystal Methamphetamine Task Force; and,

21 WHEREAS, grant funds provide for one FTE police officer position
22 to provide direct services exclusively to target Methamphetamine
23 trafficking and distribution; this grant funded position will be "G"
24 coded and terminated upon completion of the grant funding; and,

25 WHEREAS the grant does not require an ASO amendment; and,

1 WHEREAS, The grant terms prohibit including indirect costs in
2 the grant budget; now, therefore, be it

3 RESOLVED, That the Chief of Police for the City and County of
4 San Francisco is authorized on behalf of the City and County of San
5 Francisco to retroactively accept and expend continued funding for
6 this project from the Governor's Office of Emergency Services; and be
7 it

8 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives
9 inclusion of indirect costs in the grant budget; and be it

10 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Chief of Police of the City and
11 County of San Francisco is authorized to execute on behalf of the
12 City and County of San Francisco the necessary Grant Agreement for
13 this project including any extensions, funding augmentations from the
14 Governor's Office of Emergency Services, or amendments thereof; and
15 be it

16 FURTHER RESOLVED, That it is agreed that any liability arising
17 out of performance of this Grant Agreement, including civil court
18 actions for damages, shall be the responsibility of the grantee and
19 the authorizing agency; and be it

20 FURTHER RESOLVED, That grant funds received hereunder shall not
21 be used to supplant expenditure controlled by the Board of
22 Supervisors, thus the position vacated through this program will be
23 backfilled contemporaneously with the same level of local funding by
24 transferring an equal sum from the Police Department's uniform salary
25 account to its uniform overtime account for that fiscal year.
