WHEREAS, The San Francisco Opera plans on honoring Bidu Sayao during the Fall Season; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco honors the life of Bidu Sayao and joins the San Francisco Opera in honoring her spirit, her great talent, and her life; and, be it
