Enclosed is the resolution that would designate *The Examiner* as the City's official newspaper for all Advertising for Fiscal Year 14-15.

The attached table, "Summary of Official Advertising Bids for FY 14-15," shows that The Examiner submitted the only responsive bid for official advertising. The San Francisco Chronicle's bid was nonresponsive because the San Francisco Chronicle is not printed in San Francisco. OCA regulations require that we officially recommend only responsive bidders for contract awards but the Board of Supervisors has historically used its discretion to award the Official Advertising contract to multiple bidders to best serve the City's official advertising needs. Last year, the Board of Supervisors recommended award of the Official Advertising contract to both newspapers in 6 month increments.

OCA also solicited bids for the services of a clearinghouse in addition to the usual bids for the official newspaper. The clearinghouse transmits the City's ads to the newspapers and handles invoicing and payment. OCA received one (1) responsive bid from The Daily Journal who has been providing clearinghouse services to the City for many years.

The total estimated contract value for FY 14-15 is \$48,000. Contract value has decreased over the last several fiscal years due to an increase in information being published on City department websites per legislative ordinance 318-10 (December 14, 2010) amending Chapter 2 of the San Francisco Administrative Code by adding Article XII, Sections 2.96 through 2.100.

The third and fourth attachments are the Mayor's and Board's versions of San Francisco Ethics Commission Form 126, "Notification of Contract Approval."

# Official Advertising

• This is a resolution requesting your approval for the contract for Official Newspaper Advertising. Its estimated annual value is \$250,000, of which approximately \$48,000 is for the Clerk of the Board.

[Annual spending on this contract has declined significantly in recent years due to an increase in public notices posted on the City's Departmental websites. 2010's Board resolution changing the Admin Code to allow for advertising of agenda summary and website address information further reduced spending on Official Advertising. With the current legislative requirements we expect current spending estimates to hold steady in the coming years. ]

- This contract is for Fiscal Year 2014/15, beginning August 1, 2014 and expiring June 30, 2015. Based on the anticipated date of approval of this Resolution and to prevent the interruption of services to City Departments, OCA executed a modification extending the previous contract term with the SF Chronicle by one month through July 31, 2014 or until this Resolution has been adopted and signed.
- Per the Admin Code requirements, OCA is required to conduct a competitive solicitation, evaluate bidder responses and recommend the highest scoring responsive bidder for contract award. This year, OCA received bids from The Examiner and SF Chronicle. The highest scoring bidder was The Examiner, scoring 30.4 out of 32 points. SF Chronicle scored 21.4 points and is non-responsive because it does not meet the requirement of being printed within City limits.
- As in prior years, the Board has the discretion to award the contract as you see fit to serve the City's needs for public noticing. Historically, the Board has awarded this contract in 6 month increments to both bidders. The Examiner has received the award for 6 months of the fiscal year and SF Chronicle has received the award for 6 months.
- I have included the bid evaluation and point scores per Admin Code requirements in this presentation for your review. I'm joined today by members of my team and the Departmental end user's team and we're here to answer any questions you have about this contract.
