2 URGING THE OFFICE OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES, TO WORK WITH THE  
3 MAYOR'S OFFICE OF EMERGENCY SERVICES, 911 COMMAND CENTER, FIRE  
4 DEPARTMENT, POLICE DEPARTMENT AND ALL KEY CITY DEPARTMENTS TO CONDUCT  
5 A TEST RUN OF THE CITY'S PREPAREDNESS IN THE EVENT OF A CATASTROPHIC  
6 DISASTER.

8 WHEREAS, October 17, 1999 will be the 10<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the  
9 Loma Prieta earthquake; and,

10 WHEREAS, There have been several disastrous earthquakes, nuclear  
11 accidents, floods and train wrecks which have occurred in many parts  
12 of the world during these past months; and,

13 WHEREAS, It is important to test how the 911 Operations Center,  
14 Police, Fire, Paramedics and others will coordinate and communicate  
15 with each other in a state of an emergency; and,

16 WHEREAS, The state of preparedness of the City's hospitals,  
17 shelters and other facilities need to be assessed to ensure that  
18 these entities are indeed ready to handle the overwhelming request to  
19 accommodate the injured or displaced; and,

20 WHEREAS, It is imperative that in a state of an emergency that  
21 all City entities required to respond be coordinated to ensure that  
22 all services are provided in a smooth and seamless manner; now,  
23 therefore, be it

24 RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors urges the  
25 Office of Administrative Services, to work with the Mayor's Office of

1 Emergency Services, 911 Command Center, Fire Department, Police  
2 Department and all key City departments to conduct a test run of the  
3 City's preparedness in the event of a catastrophic disaster.


