 2 DIRECTING THE CLERK OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS TO NEGOTIATE WITH
 3 WALT DISNEY PICTURES FOR THE TERMS OF ACCESS AND USE OF THE BOARD OF
 4 SUPERVISORS CHAMBER FOR FILMING, FILM PREPARATION AND CLEAN-UP
 5 ACTIVITY ("FILMING ACTIVITY"), DIRECTING THE CLERK OF THE BOARD TO CONSULT
 6 WITH THE ACTING DIRECTOR OF THE FILM COMMISSION IN ENSURING THAT THE
 7 TERMS OF THE USE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY AND WALT DISNEY PICTURES
 8 ARE CONSISTENT WITH THE CITY'S GENERAL PRACTICES WITH RESPECT TO
 9 FILMING ON CITY PROPERTY AND THAT SUCH USE AGREEMENT INCLUDES ANY
 10 ADDITIONAL PROVISIONS NECESSARY TO ENSURE PROPER TREATMENT AND
 11 PROTECTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS CHAMBER, ESTABLISHING A FEE OF
 12 NO LESS THAN \$10,000 FOR THE FIRST DAY OF WALT DISNEY PICTURES' FILMING
 13 ACTIVITY IN THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS CHAMBER AND A FEE OF NO LESS THAN
 14 \$20,000 FOR EACH ADDITIONAL DAY OF SUCH FILMING ACTIVITY IN THE BOARD OF
 15 SUPERVISORS CHAMBER, ESTABLISHING THAT SUCH FILMING ACTIVITY BY WALT
 16 DISNEY PICTURES SHALL NOT INTERFERE WITH THE BUSINESS OF THE BOARD OF
 17 SUPERVISORS, AND MANDATING THAT WALT DISNEY PICTURES' FILMING ACTIVITY
 18 SHALL BE SUBJECT TO THE SPECIAL GUIDELINES FOR USE OF THE BOARD OF
 19 SUPERVISORS CHAMBER DEVELOPED BY THE CLERK OF THE BOARD OF
 20 SUPERVISORS, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE CITY ARCHITECT, THE ACTING
 21 DIRECTOR OF THE FILM COMMISSION AND THE CITY ATTORNEY.

 23 WHEREAS, Walt Disney Pictures requests the use of the Board of Supervisors
 24 Chamber as a featured location for one of its upcoming motion pictures, "Bicentennial Man,"
 25 starring Robin Williams; and,

1 WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors finds that Walt Disney Pictures' request to film
 2 in the Board of Supervisors Chamber will serve a public benefit by featuring images of the
 3 carefully refurbished City Hall and Board of Supervisors Chamber in a film and thereby
 4 fostering increased recognition of, and good will towards, the City and its important
 5 architectural works; and

6 WHEREAS, Walt Disney Pictures requests access to and use of the Board Chamber
 7 for four days at the end of April 1999, for two days of filming, one day for set-up and
 8 pre-lighting, and one day for clean-up; now, therefore, be it

9 MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors directs the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors
 10 to negotiate with Walt Disney Pictures for the terms of access and use of the Board of
 11 Supervisors Chamber for filming and for film preparation and clean-up activity ("Filming
 12 Activity"); and be it

13 FURTHER MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors directs the Clerk of the Board of
 14 Supervisors to consult with the Acting Director of the Film Commission in ensuring that the
 15 terms of the use agreement between the City and Walt Disney Pictures are consistent with
 16 the City's general practices with respect to filming on City property and that such use
 17 agreement includes any additional provisions necessary to ensure proper treatment and
 18 protection of the Board of Supervisors Chamber; and be it

19 FURTHER MOVED, That a fee of no less than \$10,000 shall be the fee for the first
 20 day of Walt Disney Pictures' Filming Activity in the Board of Supervisors Chamber and that a
 21 fee of no less than \$20,000 shall be the fee for each additional day of such Filming Activity in
 22 the Board of Supervisors Chamber; and be it

23 FURTHER MOVED, That such Filming Activity by Walt Disney Pictures shall not
 24 interfere with the business of the Board of Supervisors; and be it

Motion directing the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors to negotiate with Walt Disney Pictures for the terms of access and use of the Board of Supervisors Chambers for filming, film preparation and clean-up activity ("filming activity"), directing the Clerk of the Board to consult with the Acting Director of the Film Commission in ensuring that the terms of the use agreement between the City and Walt Disney Pictures are consistent with the City's general practices with respect to filming on City property and that such use agreement includes any additional provisions necessary to ensure proper treatment and protection of the Board of Supervisors Chambers, establishing a fee of no less than \$10,000 for the first day of Walt Disney Pictures' filming activity in the Board of Supervisors Chamber and a fee of no less than \$20,000 for each additional day of such filming activity in the Board of Supervisors Chamber, establishing that such filming activity by Walt Disney Pictures shall not interfere with the business of the Board of Supervisors, and mandating that Walt Disney Pictures' filming activity shall be subject to the special guidelines for use of the Board of Supervisors Chambers developed by the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors, in consultation with the City Architect, the Acting Director of the Film Commission and the City Attorney.


