

[Mayoral Reappointment, Municipal Transportation Agency Board of Directors - Stephanie Cajina]

Motion approving the Mayor's nomination for the reappointment of Stephanie Cajina to the Municipal Transportation Agency Board of Directors, for a term ending March 1, 2026.

WHEREAS, Article VIII.A of the City Charter, approved November 1999, establishes the Municipal Transportation Agency ("MTA") which includes the Municipal Railway and shall include the Department of Parking and Traffic; and

WHEREAS, The MTA includes a Board of Directors governed by a board of seven directors appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the Board of Supervisors; and

WHEREAS, At least four of the directors must be regular riders of the municipal railway and must continue to ride the municipal railway during their terms; and

WHEREAS, The directors must possess significant knowledge of, or professional experience in, one or more the fields of government, finance, or labor relations; and

WHEREAS, At least two of the directors must possess significant knowledge of, or professional experience in, the field of public transportation; and

WHEREAS, The Mayor has reappointed Stephanie Cajina to the MTA Board of Directors to serve a term ending March 1, 2026; now, therefore, be it

MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby approves the Mayor's nomination for the reappointment of Stephanie Cajina to the Municipal Transportation Agency Board of Directors, for the unexpired portion of a four-year term ending March 1, 2026.
