

1 [Grant Agreement - Self-Help for the Elderly - Congregate Nutrition Services for Older Adults -
2 Not to Exceed \$11,125,299]

3 **Resolution approving a Grant Agreement between the City, acting by and through the**
4 **Department of Disability and Aging Services, and Self-Help for the Elderly for the**
5 **provision of Congregate Nutrition Services for Older Adults Program, for a term of four**
6 **years from July 1, 2025, through June 30, 2029, and for a total not to exceed amount of**
7 **\$11,125,299; and to authorize the Executive Director of the Department of Disability and**
8 **Aging Services to enter into amendments or modifications to the Grant Agreement that**
9 **do not materially increase the obligations or liabilities to the City and are necessary to**
10 **effectuate the purposes of the Grant Agreement or this Resolution.**

12 WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco, by and through its Department of
13 Disability and Aging Services, wishes to provide the Congregate Nutrition Services for Older
14 Adults program to reduce hunger, food insecurity, and malnutrition of older adults living in the
15 community as well as support their safety and independence; and

16 WHEREAS, On December 31, 2024, the Department of Disability and Aging Services,
17 in coordination with the Human Services Agency, issued a Request for Proposals #1177 for
18 Congregate Nutrition Services; and

19 WHEREAS, Self-Help for the Elderly submitted a proposal and was awarded the grant
20 for the total amount of \$10,113,908 for the period of July 1, 2025, through June 30, 2029; and

21 WHEREAS, On May 7, 2025, the Department of Disability and Aging Services
22 Commission approved the proposed Congregate Nutrition for Older Adults grant with Self-
23 Help for the Elderly (the "Grant Agreement") in a total amount not to exceed \$11,125,299 for
24 the period from July 1, 2025, through June 30, 2029; and

1 WHEREAS, The City and County of San Francisco, by and through its Department of
2 Disability and Aging Services, now wishes to enter into the Grant Agreement with Self-Help
3 for the Elderly; and

4 WHEREAS, Charter, Section 9.118(b) requires Board of Supervisors' approval by
5 Resolution of any contract which, when entered into, extends over 10 years, and of any
6 contract which, when entered into, costs the City \$10,000,000 or more; and

7 WHEREAS, The proposed Grant Agreement contained in File No. _____, is
8 substantially in final form, with all material terms and conditions included, and only remains to
9 be executed by the parties upon approval of this Resolution; now, therefore, be it

10 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby approves the Grant Agreement in
11 substantially the form contained in File No. _____; and, be it

12 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors authorizes the Department of
13 Disability and Aging Services to make any modifications to the Grant Agreement, prior to its
14 final execution by all parties, that the Department of Disability and Aging Services determines,
15 in consultation with the City Attorney, are consistent with this Resolution, in the best interest of
16 the City, do not materially increase the obligations or liabilities of the City, are necessary or
17 advisable to effectuate the purposes of the Grant Agreement, and are in compliance with all
18 applicable laws, including City's Charter; and, be it

19 FURTHER RESOLVED, That within 30 days of the Grant Agreement being fully
20 executed by all parties, the Department of Disability and Aging Services shall submit to the
21 Clerk of the Board of Supervisors a completely executed copy for inclusion in File No. ____
22 _____; this requirement and obligation resides with the Department, and is for purposes of
23 having a complete file only, and in no manner affects the validity of the approved Grant
24 Agreement.
