12 Amendments to submit and sign a written Proponent ballot argument and rebuttal ballot  
13 argument for submittal to the Director of Elections as follows:

23 will submit the argument to the Director of Election no later than the deadline of noon, August  
24 19, 2003, and the rebuttal ballot argument no later than noon, August 26, 2003; now therefore

1            MOVED, that the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the sponsors of the measure  
2 to submit and sign a written Proponent ballot argument and rebuttal ballot argument.

3            FURTHER, that the sponsor may authorize or assign any other person(s) under the  
4 provisions of the San Francisco Elections Code Section 550(e) the authority to submit the  
5 rebuttal arguments.
