Resolution authorizing the Mayor's Office of Housing and Community Development ("MOHCD") to execute the Standard Agreements with the California Department of Housing and Community Development ("HCD") under the Affordable Housing and Sustainable Communities Program for a total award of \$45,721,399, including \$33,000,000 disbursed by HCD as a loan to the Balboa Gateway, L.P. ("Developer") for a 100% affordable housing project at 11 Frida Kahlo Way and \$12,721,399 to be disbursed as a grant to the City for public transportation improvements near 11 Frida Kahlo Way, for the period starting on the execution date of the Standard Agreements through November 30, 2043; authorizing MOHCD to accept and expend the grant of up to \$12,721,399 for transportation, streetscape and pedestrian improvements and other transit oriented programming and improvement as approved by HCD.

WHEREAS, The State of California, the Strategic Growth Council ("SGC") and the California Department of Housing and Community Development ("HCD") issued a Notice of Funding Availability ("NOFA") dated January 30, 2023, and subsequently amended on March 15, 2023, under the Affordable Housing and Sustainable Communities ("AHSC") Program established under Division 44, Part 1 of the Public Resources Code commencing with Section 75200; and

WHEREAS, The SGC is authorized to approve funding allocations for the AHSC Program, subject to the terms and conditions of the NOFA, AHSC Program Guidelines adopted by SGC on December 15, 2022 ("Program Guidelines"), an application package

1	released by HCD for the AHSC Program ("Application Package"), and AHSC STD 213 and				
2	STD 215 standard agreements with the State of California ("Standard Agreements"), and HCI				
3	is authorized to administer the approved funding allocations of the AHSC Program; and				
4	WHEREAS, The AHSC Program provides grants and loans to applicants identified				
5	through a competitive process for the development of projects that, per the Program				
6	Guidelines, will create new affordable housing and achieve greenhouse gas reductions and				
7	benefit disadvantaged communities through increased accessibility to affordable housing,				
8	employment centers and key destinations via low-carbon transportation; and				
9	WHEREAS, The AHSC Program requires that joint applicants for a project will be held				
10	jointly and severally liable for completion of such project; and				
11	WHEREAS, Balboa Gateway L.P., a California limited partnership ("Developer"),				
12	requested that the City and County of San Francisco (the "City"), acting by and through				
13	Mayor's Office of Housing and Community Development ("MOHCD"), be a joint applicant for				
14	AHSC Program funds for its project located at 11 Frida Kahlo Way consisting of new				
15	construction of a 159-unit 100% affordable multifamily rental housing development affordable				
16	to low-income households(the "Project") identified as Balboa Building A (the "Balboa Building				
17	A"); and				
18	WHEREAS, In order to be highly competitive for the AHSC funds, the Developer and				
19	MOHCD applied for AHSC grant funds to purchase Bay Area Rapid Transit "BART" vehicles				
20	("BART vehicles") in order to further reduce greenhouse gas emissions; and				
21	WHEREAS, On April 3, 2023, BART and the Developer entered into an Implementation				
22	Agreement to make commitments related to the purchase of the BART vehicles as included in				
23	the Application package; and

1	WHEREAS, On March 31, 2023, the San Francisco Municipal Transportation Authority
2	("SFMTA") and MOHCD entered into a Memorandum of Understanding to make commitments
3	related to 29 Sunset Improvement Project included in the Application package; and
4	WHEREAS, On April 14, 2023, the Board of Supervisors authorized MOHCD to apply
5	for AHSC Program funds and submit an Application Package as a joint applicant with the
6	Developer through Resolution No. 153-23; and
7	WHEREAS, HCD proposes to maximize the use of available grant funds on program
8	expenditures by not including indirect costs in the grant budget; and
9	WHEREAS, Through an award letter dated September 1, 2023, HCD made an award
10	in the total amount of \$45,721,399, which includes \$33,000,000 to be disbursed by HCD as a
11	loan to the Developer for the Project, and up to \$12,721,399 to be disbursed as a grant to the
12	City for the BART vehicles, other transit-oriented programming and improvements, and AHD
13	resident support approved by HCD, subject to the terms and conditions of the Standard
14	Agreements, copies of which are on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No.
15	; now, therefore, be it
16	RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors approves and authorizes the MOHCD to
17	enter into the Standard Agreements with HCD, with terms and conditions that AHSC Program
18	funds are to be used for allowable capital asset project expenditures identified in Exhibit A;
19	and, be it
20	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of
21	indirect costs in the grant budget; and, be it
22	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board Supervisors authorizes the City to accept and
23	expend the grant funds disbursed under the Standard Agreements; and, be it
24	FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors authorizes the Director of

MOHCD (or his designee) to execute and deliver any documents in the name of the MOHCD

1	that are necessary, appropriate or advisable to accept and expend the AHSC Program funds
2	from HCD, and all amendments thereto, and complete the transactions contemplated herein
3	and to use the funds for eligible capital asset(s) in the manner presented in the application as
4	approved by HCD and in accordance with the NOFA and Program Guidelines and Application
5	Package; and, be it
6	FURTHER RESOLVED, That all actions authorized and directed by this Resolution and
7	heretofore taken are ratified, approved and confirmed by this Board of Supervisors; and, be it
8	FURTHER RESOLVED, That within thirty (30) days of the Standard Agreements being
9	fully executed by all parties, MOHCD shall provide the final agreement to the Clerk of the
10	Board for inclusion into the official file.
