WHEREAS, The Board of Supervisors has reviewed the schedule and has approved a schedule which the Board believes will result in audit findings which will be most effective in improving services to the people of San Francisco; now, therefore, be it

MOVED, That the Budget Analyst is hereby directed to include in its schedule of audits, in the following order of priority, the Recreation and Parks Department and the Department of Public Works; and, be it

FURTHER MOVED, That the Budget Analyst is hereby directed to prepare a report in conjunction with the Controller to meet the FY 2006-2007 funding requirements for the Public Education Enrichment Fund as required by Charter Section 16.123-2; and, be

FURTHER MOVED, That the Budget Analyst is authorized to initiate focused special projects to the extent that staff resources are available and if there are no pending special
