8 Action's employment counseling program in 1974 and helped develop the  
9 program into a nationally recognized model; and,

10 WHEREAS, Isabel Huie has served as Chinese for Affirmative  
11 Action's Civil Rights Officer since 1991 and has provided assistance  
12 and support to thousands of individuals who experienced racial  
13 discrimination and harassment; and,

14 WHEREAS, Isabel Huie helped found and served as the first  
15 Executive Director of the Northeast Community Federal Credit Union to  
16 provide banking services and loans to low- and moderate-income  
17 families and individuals in San Francisco's Chinatown; and,

18 WHEREAS, Isabel Huie has played an important leadership role in  
19 the development of San Francisco's Asian American nonprofit  
20 community; and,

21 WHEREAS, Isabel Huie's tireless work over the past three decades  
22 has resulted in stronger protection for Asian Americans and  
23 immigrants and forged a stronger civil rights movement; and,
