I'd like comment on Agenda Item 1 on the 1/13/2023 meeting agenda:

My children are SFUSD alumni, K-12. The Central office Curriculum and Instruction department has ballooned since Richard Carranza was Superintendent. The math department in particular. SFUSD has created and uses its own k-10 math curriculum and has built a cottage industry of support around it. This would be the first place I'd look for wasteful spending. They also created a compression course called "Algebra 2+ Precalculus" which UC/CSU does not recognize as precalculus and categorizes it as Algebra 2. Support costs for this in house class, which isn't even what it is claimed to be, should be reviewed.
