

1 [New grant from the California Department of Health Services, TB Control, for bioterrorism
2 preparedness and regional civil detention of persistently non-adherent tuberculosis patients.]

3 **Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health (SFDPH) to**
4 **accept retroactively and expend a new grant in the amount of \$995,759 from the**
5 **California Department of Health Services, TB Control Unit (CDHSTB) for the**
6 **bioterrorism preparedness and dual use project for regional civil detention of**
7 **persistently non-adherent tuberculosis patients, and to enter into an agreement for the**
8 **use of these funds; for the period of April 27, 2005, to January 1, 2013.**

10 WHEREAS, SFDPH has applied for and been awarded a grant from CDHSTB in the
11 amount of \$995,759 for the bioterrorism preparedness and dual use project for regional civil
12 detention of persistently non-adherent tuberculosis patients; and,

13 WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the grant funds, CDHSTB requires the City to
14 enter into an agreement (the "Agreement"), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the
15 Board of Supervisors in File No. 051296, which is hereby declared to be a part of this
16 resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,

17 WHEREAS, This Resolution requires expedited review by the Board of Supervisors
18 because notification of the award was not received from CDHSTB until April 27, 2005; and,

19 WHEREAS, Resolutions authorizing the acceptance and expenditure of grant funds
20 may be placed automatically on the consent agendas in committee, as they are usually
21 considered to be routine items, and this resolution authorizes the acceptance and expenditure
22 of grant funding; and,

23 WHEREAS, The grant terms prohibit including indirect costs in the grant budget; now,
24 therefore, be it

1 RESOLVED, That SFDPH is hereby authorized to accept retroactively and expend a
2 grant in the amount of \$995,759 from CDHSTB; and, be it

3 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of
4 indirect costs in the grant budget; and, be it

5 FURTHER RESOLVED, That SFDPH is hereby authorized to accept and expend the
6 grant funds in accordance with the requirements set forth in the Agreement pursuant to San
7 Francisco Administrative Code section 10-170-1; and, be it

8 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the
9 agreement on behalf of the City.
