It's a place where it goes without question that you can marry who you love regardless of gender; where immigrants and refugees are human beings deserving dignity and civil rights; where your gender identity is met with acceptance instead of hostility; where language shouldn't be a barrier to government services; where there are active religious and ethnic communities who not only organize together but support each other. While my personal demographics aren't particularly noteworthy, I would approach this role knowing that I am accountable not only to my community, but to every community.

Geographically, I live in Western Addition, work in the Tenderloin, and rely on my feet and public transportation everywhere else I need to go. I was raised in Phoenix and moved to San Francisco three years ago from San Diego. However, in the years in between, I have lived in every state along the U.S.-Mexico border, as well as in Japan, England, and Ghana.

While I certainly belong to a privileged demographic, I have dedicated much of my professional career to covering a broad array of community concerns, including LGBTQ issues, indigenous rights, the plights of refugees, mental health and homelessness, and juvenile justice reform. I hold a master's degree in social anthropology, having graduated from a program that involved researching and understanding a globally diverse range of cultures and communities, with a specific focus on inmate populations.

I was a recipient of the 2014 "Unsung Hero Award" from the Youth Law Center for my work on juvenile justice and the 2015 Neil Morgan Community Impact Award from the Society of Professional Journalists San Diego Chapter for my work on deaths in jail custody.

## Business and/or professional experience:

I have worked at the Electronic Frontier Foundation since the beginning of 2013, most recently as an investigative researcher on the activism team. EFF is a San Francisco-based international non-profit that defends civil liberties, privacy, and innovation in the increasingly digital world. This often includes standing up for users by exposing and criticizing invasive and irresponsible practices by corporations. In my case, specifically, I have done much work on the relationships

between government agencies and tech vendors and how these interactions impact the public.

My core strength on this committee would be my knowledge and experience with government transparency in many different jurisdictions, but especially with the California Public Records Act and the Brown Act. I have attended public meetings and filed public-records requests across the state and across the country, so I have context with which to evaluate what works and what doesn't.

Prior to EFF, I worked professionally as a journalist since 1998, with much of my career as an investigative reporter utilizing public records laws to uncover injustice, waste, and corruption

Among my personal experience and accomplishments:

- Organized grassroots activism campaigns to prevent the California legislature from weakening the California Public Records Act and to strengthen the law through Proposition 42.
- Partnered with MuckRock News to file more than 200 public records requests around the country to learn how local law enforcement agencies use mobile biometrics devices.
- Coordinated Sunshine Week activities and coverage for EFF (2014-2015),
   San Diego CityBeat (2010-2012), and the Santa Fe Reporter (2008).
- Created government data indexes in Arizona, New Mexico and California, including Open San Diego's "Flashlight" project.
- Written extensively on transparency issues, including live streaming of legislatures, public-records appeal processes, and public records lawsuits and court rulings.
- Successfully challenged the Texas Department of Corrections rejection of public records requests related to death row inmates.
- My public-records investigations helped lead to the conviction of a public official for embezzlement, the dissolution of an overspending local agency, and state divestment of \$45 million from corporations working in the Sudan.
- One of the first journalists in the country to begin live-blogging state and local meetings, including New Mexico legislative sessions and San Diego's annual "Election Central" events.


- Led and participated in workshops on access to public records at Dragon Con, Sunlight Foundation's Transparency Camp, "News Foo," and Occupy San Diego.

- Close working relationship with some of the state's most influential transparency organizations, such as Californians Aware, First Amendment Coalitions, and several ACLU chapters, as well as national organizations, such as the Sunlight Foundation and MuckRock News.

## Civic Activities:

As an employee of a non-profit, I work full time in the public interest. This includes interfacing with communities and policymakers around the country.

Outside of EFF, I have dedicated my free time to using public records to reveal problems in county jails and the juvenile justice system in California. This has included work to liberate data on deaths in custody from local agencies and the California Department of Justice, ultimately influencing the Attorney General's decision to use this data as one of the first projects on openjustice.doj.ca.gov.

My work related to juvenile detention resulted in the passage of a law in 2015 reforming how strip searches are conducting with juveniles. My work has also led to the State Advisory Committee on Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention making the use of pepper spray on juveniles in detention a priority issue.



### **Board Qualifications:**

The Sunshine Ordinance Task Force (the "Task Force") was established to advise the Board of Supervisors and provide information to other City departments on appropriate ways in which to implement Administrative Code, Chapter 67 (The San Francisco Sunshine Ordinance of 1999) (the "Ordinance"). The Task Force shall develop goals to ensure practice and timely implementation of the Ordinance; propose amendments to the Ordinance; receive and review the annual report of the Supervisor of Public Records and may request additional reports or information; and make referrals to a municipal office with enforcement power under the Ordinance, the California Public Records Act, or the Brown Act, whenever it concludes a person has violated the provisions of the Ordinance.

The Task Force consists of a total of thirteen (13) members:

- > Eleven (11) voting members appointed by the Board of Supervisors
- Two (2) members nominated by the local chapter of the Society of Professional Journalists; one (1) shall be an attorney and one (1) shall be a journalist.
  - One (1) member shall be a member from the press or electronic media.
- One (1) member shall be a journalist from a racial/ethnic-minority-owned news organization and nominated by New California Media.
  - One (1) member nominated by the local chapter of the League of Women Voters.
  - Two (2) members of the public experienced in consumer advocacy.
  - Four (4) members of the public who have demonstrated interest in, or have experience in,

the issues of citizen access and participation in local government.

- > One (1) member shall be the Mayor, or his/her designee, and serve as a non-voting member.
- > One (1) member shall be the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors, or his/her designee, and serve as a non-voting member.

At all times, the Task Force shall include at least one member who shall be a member of the public who is physically handicapped. All members must have experience and/or demonstrated interested in the issues of citizen access and participation in local government. The City Attorney's Office shall assign an attorney to the Task Force who is experienced in public-access law matters and serve as a legal advisor and advocate to the Task Force.

The term of each appointed member shall be two years unless removed by the Board of Supervisors. In the event of such removal or vacancy during the term of office of any appointive member, a successor shall be appointed for the unexpired term of the office vacated.

In addition to regular Task Force meetings, Task Force members are expected to participate in committee work.

Reports: The Task Force shall report annually to the Board of Supervisors on any practical or policy problems encountered in the Administration of the Ordinance. The Task Force shall, as it sees fit, issue public reports evaluating compliance with the Ordinance and related California laws by the City or any department, office or official.
