10 Gerald Miller, seat 1, succeeding Ronald Sanders, term expired, for the unexpired  
11 portion of a two-year term ending July 17, 2013. Member must be a former inmate in the San  
12 Francisco County Jail, a California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation facility and/or  
13 a United States Bureau of Prison facility.

14 Kimberli Courtney, seat 2, succeeding Mary Campbell, term expired, for the unexpired  
15 portion of a two-year term ending July 17, 2013. Member must be a former inmate in the San  
16 Francisco County Jail, a California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation facility and/or  
17 a United States Bureau of Prison facility. The member shall also have expertise in providing  
18 services to individuals exiting the criminal justice system.

19 Viet Mike Ngo, seat 3, succeeding Gerald Miller, term expired, for the unexpired portion  
20 of a two-year term ending July 17, 2013. Member must be a former inmate in the San  
21 Francisco County Jail, a California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation facility and/or  
22 a United States Bureau of Prison facility. The member must also have been released from  
23 custody within two years of his or her appointment.

2 portion of a two-year term ending July 17, 2013. Member must be a former inmate in the San  
3 Francisco County Jail, a California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation facility and/or  
4 a United States Bureau of Prison facility. The member must also have served multiple terms  
5 of incarceration.
