[National Coalition for the Homeless Proclamation] COMMENDING THE NATIONAL COALITION FOR THE HOMELESS AND PROCLAIMING OCTOBER 2, 1999 "NATIONAL DAY OF CIVIL RIGHTS OF HOMELESS PEOPLE".

WHEREAS, On October 2, 1999, organizations and individuals from the Bay Area, along with members of the National Coalition for the Homeless and others from across the country, will join in San Francisco to launch the National Coalition for the Homeless Civil Rights Organizing Project (NHCROP); and,

WHEREAS, The National Coalition for the Homeless is the nation's oldest and largest national homeless advocacy organization whose goal is to end homelessness; and,

WHEREAS, To achieve this goal, the National Coalition for the Homeless focuses on housing that is affordable to those with the lowest income, accessible and comprehensive health care and other needed support services, livable incomes, and the civil rights of those who are without homes; and,

WHEREAS, The National Coalition for the Homeless has recently launched NHCROP as an effort to combat the growing tide of antihomeless legislation and civil rights violations across the county; and

WHEREAS, Homeless residents have increasingly become the target of hate crimes and discriminatory ordinances that serve only to jail or hide homeless people; and

WHEREAS, NHCROP seeks to stop policies and practices that discriminate against homeless people or criminalize them for being homeless; and

WHEREAS, NHCROP will bring together homeless people, advocates, service providers and other individuals around the country who are committed to ending civil rights abuses against homeless people; and

WHEREAS, NHCROP will utilize myriad strategies, which will include community organizing, public education and litigation; and

WHEREAS, NHCROP has proposed field sites across the nation, one of which will be in San Francisco; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors for the City and County of San Francisco commends the National Coalition for the Homeless for its tireless advocacy on behalf of homeless individuals and on its establishment of the National Homeless Civil Rights Organizing Project; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby proclaims October 2, 1999 "National Day of Civil Rights of Homeless People".
