5 WHEREAS, In 1989, the Loma Prieta Earthquake critically damaged  
6 City Hall causing it to be closed in 1995; and

7 WHEREAS, In 1990, voters approved the issuance of \$187 million  
8 in general obligation bonds to seismically retrofit City Hall; and

9 WHEREAS, In 1995, voters approved the issuance of \$63.6 million  
10 in general obligation bonds to provide technical upgrades and bring  
11 City Hall in compliance with all ADA requirements; and

12 WHEREAS, On January 5, 1999, City Hall reopened modernized,  
13 seismically retrofitted and accessible to all, including the  
14 physically challenged; and

15 WHEREAS, City Hall is now people oriented with a one-stop-shop  
16 enabling San Francisco residents to conduct business with the City,  
17 including paying taxes, buying a fast pass or a residential parking  
18 permit in one central location; and

19 WHEREAS, Over 550 highly skilled laborers, apprentices,  
20 finishers, journeymen, foremen, superintendents, artisans,  
21 craftsmen and clerical support demonstrated great skill and  
22 workmanship and worked tirelessly to complete the City Hall  
23 renovations on time; now, therefore, be it




