APPROVING REQUEST BY AC TRANSIT TO OPERATE ITS LD ROUTE FROM THE TRANSBAY TERMINAL TO POWELL AND BAY STREETS TWICE DAILY ON WEEK DAYS FOR APPROXIMATELY SEVEN WEEKS BEGINNING DECEMBER 6, 1999, AND ENDING NO LATER THAN JANUARY 31, 2000, FOR THE PURPOSE OF TRANSPORTING

PERSONS TO A WELFARE-TO-WORK TRAINING PROGRAM

WHEREAS, Alameda Contra County Transit District ("AC Transit") operates a bus route from Richmond to the Transbay Terminal in San Francisco ("LD Route"); and,

WHEREAS, AC Transit has obtained "welfare-to-work" grant funds from Contra Costa County to deliver and pick up passengers between North Richmond and Powell and Bay Streets for a seven-week training program; and,

WHEREAS, Section 25806 of the Public Utilities Code authorizes AC Transit to enter into arrangements for the joint use of property with cities operating transit facilities; and

WHEREAS, AC Transit has requested that the City permit it to operate its LD Route from the Transbay Terminal to Powell and Bay Streets over a portion of MUNI's 32-Embarcadero route for approximately seven weeks, commencing December 6, 1999 and ending no later than January 31, 2000, dropping off passengers at Powell and Bay Streets at approximately 7:00 a.m. and picking them up at approximately 4:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, with no other stops along the route; and

WHEREAS, AC Transit requests that its buses use the MUNI stop at the southwest corner of Powell Street at Bay to drop off and pick up passengers, but will use its best efforts not to interfere with regular MUNI service along the route; and

WHEREAS, The General Manager of the Public Transportation Department has recommended approval of AC Transit's request; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, That this Board of Supervisors approves the request of AC Transit to operate and extend its LD Route from the Transbay Terminal to Powell and Bay Streets for approximately seven weeks, beginning December 6, 1999 and ending no later than January 31, 1999, for the purpose of transporting persons from North Richmond in Contra Costa County to a welfare-to-work training program in San Francisco.
