

1 [AC Transit Temporary Bus Route]
2 APPROVING REQUEST BY AC TRANSIT TO OPERATE ITS LD ROUTE FROM THE
3 TRANSBAY TERMINAL TO POWELL AND BAY STREETS TWICE DAILY ON WEEK DAYS
4 FOR APPROXIMATELY SEVEN WEEKS BEGINNING DECEMBER 6, 1999, AND ENDING
5 NO LATER THAN JANUARY 31, 2000, FOR THE PURPOSE OF TRANSPORTING
6 PERSONS TO A WELFARE-TO-WORK TRAINING PROGRAM

7 WHEREAS, Alameda Contra County Transit District ("AC Transit") operates a bus
8 route from Richmond to the Transbay Terminal in San Francisco ("LD Route"); and,

9 WHEREAS, AC Transit has obtained "welfare-to-work" grant funds from Contra Costa
10 County to deliver and pick up passengers between North Richmond and Powell and Bay
11 Streets for a seven-week training program; and,

12 WHEREAS, Section 25806 of the Public Utilities Code authorizes AC Transit to enter
13 into arrangements for the joint use of property with cities operating transit facilities; and

14 WHEREAS, AC Transit has requested that the City permit it to operate its LD Route
15 from the Transbay Terminal to Powell and Bay Streets over a portion of MUNI's 32-
16 Embarcadero route for approximately seven weeks, commencing December 6, 1999 and
17 ending no later than January 31, 2000, dropping off passengers at Powell and Bay Streets at
18 approximately 7:00 a.m. and picking them up at approximately 4:00 p.m., Monday through
19 Friday, with no other stops along the route; and

20 WHEREAS, AC Transit requests that its buses use the MUNI stop at the southwest
21 corner of Powell Street at Bay to drop off and pick up passengers, but will use its best efforts
22 not to interfere with regular MUNI service along the route; and


23 WHEREAS, The General Manager of the Public Transportation Department has


