15 hereby urges President Bush to rescind his executive order banning Project Labor
16 Agreements (PLAs) on all construction projects involving federal money and affirming the City
17 and County of San Francisco's support of PLAs as a useful tool for safeguarding fair and
18 equitable labor practices.
