9 WHEREAS, The State of California, Department of Housing and Community
10 Development issued an Allocation Acceptance form, dated October 1, 2021, under the
11 Transitional Housing Program for \$8,000,000 authorized by item 2240-102-0001 of
12 Section 2.00 of the Budget Act of 2021 (Chapter 69 of the Statutes of 2021 (SB 129) and
13 Chapter 11.7 (commencing with Section 50807) of Part 2 of Division 31 of the Health and
14 Safety Code; and

15 WHEREAS, The Allocation Acceptance form relates to the availability of Transitional
16 Housing Program funds for the purpose of housing stability to help young adults 18 to 25
17 years old secure and maintain housing, with priority given to young adults formerly in the
18 foster care or probation systems; and

19 WHEREAS, City and County of San Francisco was included in the Allocation
20 Acceptance form dated October 5, 2021, as a county child welfare agency eligible to apply for
21 funding; and

22 WHEREAS, The total allocation of \$459,200 shall be distributed to county child welfare
23 services agencies based on each county's percentage of the total statewide number of young
24 adults aged 18 to 25 years in foster care; now, therefore, be it

1 RESOLVED, That the Human Services Agency is hereby authorized to apply for and
2 accept the Transitional Housing Program Allocation award, as detailed in the Allocation
3 Acceptance form, up to the amount authorized by the Allocation Acceptance form and
4 applicable state law; and, be it

5 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Executive Director of the Human Services Agency is
6 hereby authorized to act on behalf of the City and County of San Francisco in connection with
7 the Transitional Housing Program Allocation award, and to enter into, execute, and deliver
8 any and all documents required or deemed necessary or appropriate to be awarded the
9 Transitional Housing Program Allocation award, and all amendments thereto; and, be it

10 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Human Services Agency will use the Transitional
11 Housing Program award funds in accordance with the Allocation Acceptance form, other
12 applicable rules and laws, and the Transitional Housing Program requirements.

Pursuant to item 2240-102-0001 of Section 2.00 of the Budget Act of 2021 (Chapter 69 of the Statutes of 2021 ([SB 129](#)) and Chapter 11.7 (commencing with Section 50807) of Part 2 of Division 31 of the Health and Safety Code (HSC), the Department of Housing and Community Development (HCD) shall allocate \$8,000,000 in funding of the Transitional Housing Program (THP) to counties for the purpose of housing stability to help young adults 18 to 24 years secure and maintain housing, with priority given to young adults formerly in the foster care or probation systems.

In agreement with the Department of Social Services, the Department of Finance, and the County Welfare Directors Association, the allocation for Round 3 of the Transitional Housing Program will remain the same as Round 2. As with Round 2, this allocation excludes Alpine and Sierra because their calculation did not demonstrate a need for young adults aged 18 to 24.

In order to accept and receive an allocation for Round 3, applicants must submit the following: **Signed Allocation Acceptance form, Signed Resolution, and a signed GovTIN form.** HCD will only accept completed applications and relevant documentation via email to THP@hcd.ca.gov no later than **5:00 p.m. on Friday, November 12, 2021**. Please find attached the THP Allocation Acceptance form, Resolution template and GOVTIN form. These forms can also be found on the [THP](#) webpage. The Department may grant extensions for Signed Resolutions upon request. If your county is in need of an extension for the Signed Resolution, please email request to THP@hcd.ca.gov no later than 5:00 p.m. on Friday November 12, 2021.
