3 **Resolution authorizing the Airport Commission to accept and expend a grant in the**
4 **amount of \$518,266.00 from the Transportation Security Administration to develop,**
5 **test, and apply real-time automated video surveillance technologies.**

7 WHEREAS, On May 6, 2004, the Transportation Security Administration (TSA)
8 awarded the Cooperative Research Agreement Number 2004-G-023 to San Francisco
9 International Airport for its SmartCatch research project in the amount of \$518,266.00; and,

10 WHEREAS, On June 1, 2004, the Airport Commission adopted Resolution No. 04-0114
11 authorizing the Airport Director to accept and expend the grant award pursuant to Board of
12 Supervisors approval in accordance with Section 10.170-1 of the San Francisco
13 Administrative Code; and

14 WHEREAS, This Grant will allow San Francisco International Airport to address two
15 significant security concerns identified by Aviation Security – the first being detection and
16 identification of suspicious activities near exit lanes or passenger screening checkpoints and
17 the second being detection of anomalous activities at the publicly accessible perimeter of the
18 passenger terminals; and,

19 WHEREAS, The pilot program to be established with this grant will demonstrate not
20 only real-time detection of suspicious or prohibited behaviors, but also the useful integration of
21 that detection into the procedures and workflow of the Aviation Security unit; and,

22 WHEREAS, The system will automatically generate alerts based upon violations, log
23 each event and enable Security Operations Center monitors to replay all violations for forensic
24 search and analysis; and,

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby waives inclusion of indirect costs in the grant budget.




