9	Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:
10	Section 1. Findings.
11	A. In conjunction with Ordinances [DPH], [DBI], and [DPW
12	Subdivision]on file with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File Nos. ,
13	, and , this Ordinance enacts a new program to protect human health and safety and
14	the environment at the former Hunters Point Shipyard during and after development and to
15	facilitate redevelopment as envisioned in the Hunters Point Shipyard Redevelopment Plan
16	through enacting additional prerequisites to obtaining certain City permits. This Ordinance
17	would amend the Public Works Code to enact consistent provisions with respect to permits
18	issued by the Department of Public Works.
19	B. In accordance with the actions contemplated herein, this Board adopted Resolution
20	No. , concerning findings pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act
21	(California Public Resources Code sections 21000 et seq.). Said Resolution is on file with the
22	Clerk of the Board of Supervisors in File No and is incorporated herein by
23	reference.
24	Section 2. The San Francisco Public Works Code is hereby amended by adding
25	Sections 2.3.1, 2.3.2, and 2.3.3 to read as follows:

1	Sec. 2.3.1. Hunters Point Shipyard Permitting.
2	Notwithstanding any other provision of this Code, applicants for any permit for Hunters Point
3	Shipyard Parcel A, which involves the disturbance of at least 50 cubic yards (38.23m³) of soil or the
4	extraction or management of groundwater, except for purposes of environmental characterization,
5	shall comply with the requirements of Article 31 of the Health Code. Hunters Point Shipyard Parcel A
6	is that area of the City and County of San Francisco shown on Figure 1-1, which is maintained for
7	public distribution by the Director. A copy of said figure is on file with the Clerk of the Board of
8	Supervisors in File No
9	Section 2.3.2. Permit Approval.
10	No permit application subject to the requirements of this Section 2.3.1 shall be deemed to be
11	complete until the Department receives written notification from the Director of Public Health that the
12	applicant has complied with all applicable provisions of Article 31 of the Health Code. Approvals or
13	conditions imposed in writing by Department of Public Health shall become conditions of the permit
14	issued by the Department, and violation of such approvals or conditions shall be deemed a violation of
15	the permit.
16	Section 2.3.3. Permit Application Notification.
17	All applications for permits subject to Section 2.3.1 shall bear notice of the above requirements
18	and of the permittee's responsibility to comply.
