11 WHEREAS, In order to improve the daily operation of MUNI, allocate additional funding,  
12 and make long term planning goals, it is imperative that the Board of Supervisors have access  
13 to accurate information about MUNI's daily operations; now, therefore, be it

14 RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco  
15 hereby urges MUNI to provide daily operations reports to the Board of Supervisors.




