8 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

9 Section 1. The San Francisco Police Code is hereby amended by amending Section
10 2809, to read as follows:

11 Sec. 2809. HOURS OF BUSINESS.

12 No person, firm, corporation, co-partnership or association shall engage in the business of
13 pawnbroking or keep ~~his~~ its place of business open or transact any business therein on any
14 day except Monday through Friday between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 6:30 p.m., and
15 Saturday and Sunday between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 7:30 p.m. No person, firm,
16 corporation, co-partnership or association shall engage in the business of pawnbroking or
17 keep ~~his~~ its place of business open or transact business ~~therein~~ on any of the following days, ~~to~~
18 ~~wit: All Sundays of the year, New Year's Day, Washington's Birthday~~ President's Day, Memorial
19 Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day, and whenever
20 any of said days shall fall on Sunday the prohibition herein contained against transacting said


