

1 [Identify barriers to accessing preventive oral health care among various ethnic/racial
2 caregivers of children in San Francisco between 1 and 5 years of age.]

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4 **Resolution authorizing the San Francisco Department of Public Health (SFDPH) to**
5 **enter retroactively into an agreement in the amount of \$129,938 with The Regents of the**
6 **University of California (UCR), the primary contractor, to understand ethnic/racial**
7 **cultural differences related to children’s oral health, under the second year of an award**
8 **from the National Institutes of Health (NIH); for the period of August 1, 2002, to July 31,**
9 **2003.**

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11 WHEREAS, UCR is the recipient of a grant from NIH for the conduct of a program titled
12 “Center to Address Disparities in Children’s Oral Health”; and,

13 WHEREAS, It is considered in the best interests of NIH, UCR, and SFDPH to
14 participate in this project; and,

15 WHEREAS, UCR has agreed to reimburse SFDPH in the amount of \$129,938 for the
16 second year of the award; and,

17 WHEREAS, As a condition of receiving the funds UCR requires SFDPH to enter into a
18 subcontract (The “Agreement”), a copy of which is on file with the Clerk of the Board of
19 Supervisors in File No. _____, which is hereby declared to be a part of this
20 resolution as if set forth fully herein; and,

21 WHEREAS, The subcontract budget includes provision for indirect costs of \$3,298;
22 now, therefore, be it

23 RESOLVED, That SFDPH is hereby authorized to enter retroactively into a subcontract
24 agreement in the amount of \$129,938 with UCR, the primary contractor; and, be it

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1 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Director of Health is authorized to enter into the
2 Agreement on behalf of the City; and, be it

3 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Controller is directed to designate positions funded
4 under this agreement as “G” or grant-funded positions which would terminate when the
5 agreement expires.
