2 SUSPENDING RULE 2.28.1 OF THE RULES OF ORDER OF THE BOARD OF
3 SUPERVISORS TO PERMIT SUPERVISOR TENG TO INTRODUCE A PROPOSED
4 CHARTER AMENDMENT CONCERNING HEALTH BENEFITS FOR RETIRED CITY
5 EMPLOYEES ON TUESDAY, MAY 30, 2000, FOR POSSIBLE REFERRAL TO THE
6 VOTERS AT THE NOVEMBER 7, 2000 ELECTION.

8 WHEREAS, Rule 2.28.1 of the Rules of Order of the Board of Supervisors requires
9 that charter amendments shall be introduced by a Supervisor at a regular Board meeting held
10 not less than 168 days prior to the election at which it is to be acted upon by the electors;
11 and,

12 WHEREAS, May 22, 2000, was the deadline for any member of the Board to submit
13 the complete text of proposed charter amendments for the November 7, 2000 election; and,

14 WHEREAS, Supervisor Teng has indicated an intention to submit a proposed measure
15 and requested that the Rules of Order be suspended for the purpose of introducing a charter
16 amendment on May 30, 2000 after the deadline date; now, therefore, be it

17 MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco, as
18 allowed by Rule 4.37 of its Rules of Order, hereby suspends Rule 2.28.1 to permit Supervisor
19 Teng to introduce a charter amendment concerning health benefits for retired city employees
20 on May 30, 2000, for possible referral to the voters at the November 7, 2000 election.
