

1 [PUC sale of water-efficient toilets.]

2  
3 **Resolution announcing the final sale this year of low-cost water-efficient toilets to San**  
4 **Francisco residents, to be held in the Sunset District.**

5  
6 WHEREAS, the City and County of San Francisco and its San Francisco Public  
7 Utilities Commission are committed to water conservation; and

8 WHEREAS, the use of toilets accounts for 40% of the water used in an average home  
9 in San Francisco; and

10 WHEREAS, replacing water-inefficient toilets with water-efficient toilets in an average  
11 residential dwelling saves 21 gallons per day in a single-family home and 35 gallons of water  
12 per day in an apartment; and

13 WHEREAS, this allows the average family in San Francisco to save \$90 annually on  
14 their water bill; and

15 WHEREAS, the San Francisco Public Utilities Commission has created partnerships  
16 with community organizations over the last five years to replace 34,000 toilets throughout San  
17 Francisco; and

18 WHEREAS, the San Francisco Public Utilities Commission will be working with Sunset  
19 Youth Services to sell high quality, brand-new 1.6 gallons per flush toilets for only \$10 on  
20 Saturday, June 15 at Sunset Elementary School at 41<sup>st</sup> Avenue and Ortega from 8 a.m. to 1  
21 p.m.; and

22 WHEREAS, a portion of these proceeds will go towards Sunset Youth Services'  
23 outreach programs to children, teens and their families throughout the Sunset; now,  
24 therefore, be it

1           RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors commends the San Francisco Public  
2 Utilities Commission for helping San Francisco residents to reduce their water bills with their  
3 “High Quality, 1.6 Gallons Per Flush Toilets for Only \$10 Sale” on Saturday, June 15 from 8  
4 a.m. to 1 p.m. at Sunset Elementary School, 41<sup>st</sup> Avenue and Ortega.
