12 Be it ordained by the People of the City and County of San Francisco:

14 Section 1. The San Francisco Park Code is hereby amended by adding Sections
15 12.12, 12.13, and 12.14, to read as follows:

16 **SEC. 12.12. GOLF FEES – GOLDEN GATE PARK.**

18 Section 2. The San Francisco Park Code is hereby amended by adding Section 12.15,
19 to read as follows:

20 **SEC. 12.15. DAY CAMP FEES.**

21 *The following fees shall be charged for Recreation and Parks Department day camps:*

23 <i>Pine Lake Camp</i>	<i>\$70.00</i>
24 <i>Silver Tree Camp</i>	<i>70.00</i>
25 <i>Camp Gourmet</i>	<i>70.00</i>

1 No later than April 15th of each year, the Recreation and Parks Department shall submit its
2 current fee schedule to the Controller, who shall apply the price index adjustment to produce a new fee
3 schedule for the following year.

4 No later than May 15th of each year, the Controller shall file a report with the Board of
5 Supervisors reporting the fee new schedule and certifying that: (a) the fees produce sufficient revenue
6 to support the costs of providing the services for which each fee is assessed, and (b) the fees do not
7 produce revenue which is significantly more than the costs of providing the services for which each fee
8 is assessed.
