

I became a San Francisco resident in 2002 and have lived as a renter in District 2 for 16 years. I have worked out of offices located in District 5 (for 10 years) and District 6 (for four years). My social and professional networks in the city are broad and diverse. As a professional journalist whose application is supported by the Society of Professional Journalists' Northern California chapter, I am applying for Seat No. 2 on San Francisco's Sunshine Ordinance Task Force, which is reserved for a professional journalist who has obtained SPJ NorCal's endorsement.
I am committed to upholding the tenets of the Sunshine Ordinance for people of all communities of interest, neighborhoods and the diverse qualities that make up our populace — including ethnicity, race, age, sex, sexual orientation, gender identity, types of disabilities, and various economic, housing and citizenship statuses.
Beyond my commitment to protecting Sunshine Ordinance interests for members of all these communities, I offer a deep, specific understanding of Middle Eastern cultures based on personal and academic experience. Three of my grandparents immigrated from Lebanon, and my maternal grandmother was born in the U.S. soon after her parents arrived from the same region. I spent a significant portion of my childhood in my paternal grandparents' household. I received a B.A. from Stanford University in international relations with a regional focus on the Middle East and North Africa. I completed two years study of college-level Modern Standard Arabic.

Business and/or professional experience:

In 2008, I helped launch the San Francisco Public Press, a nonprofit, noncommercial news organization dedicated to publishing local, public-interest journalism online at sfpublishpress.org and in a quarterly print newspaper. The Public Press is independent and nonpartisan. We focus on producing in-depth, data-driven investigative reporting about policy issues in San Francisco and the Greater Bay Area. In my role as publisher, I oversee the business side of the organization and assist with editorial production.

I was previously a business reporter at the Fort Worth Star-Telegram, where I covered retail and real estate. I have a master's degree from the Columbia University Graduate School of Journalism. I am a current board member and past president of the Society of Professional Journalists' Northern California chapter.

As publisher at the Public Press and through my involvement with SPJ NorCal, I have become increasingly interested in defending public access to information and meetings as protected by law at all levels of government. It would be a great honor for me to serve my community as a member of San Francisco's Sunshine Ordinance Task Force.

In addition to my work with SPJ NorCal, I am involved with many organizations representing professional journalists. I keep myself informed about trends and changes in our industry, and am attuned to the interests and needs of a broad range of news organizations — spanning print, online and broadcast outlets of all sizes, from hyperlocal to national in scope, and including ethnic media and outlets serving disadvantaged communities. I am a founding member of the Institute for Nonprofit News and Local Independent Online News Publishers. I participate in the Bay Area Media Collaborative, an initiative to foster collaboration among news outlets around the Bay Area. I am also involved with local chapters of several national journalism organizations, including Investigative Reporters and Editors, the Online News Association and Hacks/Hackers.

In addition to my experience as a professional journalist, I have worked as a freelance writer and editor, and as a nonprofit consultant. I am also a partner in a family-owned commercial real estate business in Michigan. Through my experience with this business, I have developed a strong understanding of real estate markets, transactions and commercial lease agreements.

Civic Activities:

Much of my civic energy is directed through the Public Press, which has placed great emphasis on promoting civic engagement in San Francisco and cultivating conversations about important local issues. Earlier this year we hosted a day-long conference and workshop to educate community members about the current state of homelessness in San Francisco and to explore possible solutions. More than 200 people attended, including several representatives from the city's Department of Homelessness and Supportive Housing. In May, the Public Press co-hosted a nonpartisan candidate forum with San Francisco Black Community Matters, Black Young Democrats and San Francisco Black Leadership Forum in advance of the June 5 election. I served as moderator for this forum.

I am a board member of Artists United, an international Oakland-based nonprofit organization dedicated to helping artists network, access resources and develop business skills that will help them live sustainably and participate in community building and social advocacy initiatives.

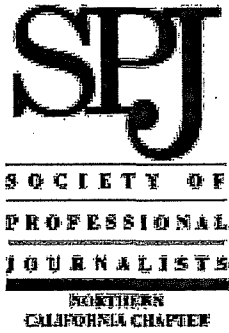

SUNSHINE ORDINANCE TASK FORCE

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Authority:

Administrative Code, Section 67.30 (Ordinance Nos. 265-93; 118-94; 432-94; 287-96; 198-96; 387-98; and Proposition G, November 1999)

Board Qualifications:

The Sunshine Ordinance Task Force (the "Task Force") was established to advise the Board of Supervisors and provide information to other City departments on appropriate ways in which to implement Administrative Code, Chapter 67 (The San Francisco Sunshine Ordinance of 1999) (the "Ordinance"). The Task Force shall develop goals to ensure practice and timely implementation of the Ordinance; propose amendments to the Ordinance; receive and review the annual report of the Supervisor of Public Records and may request additional reports or information; and make referrals to a municipal office with enforcement power under the Ordinance, the California Public Records Act, or the Brown Act, whenever it concludes a person has violated the provisions of the Ordinance.

The Task Force consists of a total of thirteen (13) members:

- > Eleven (11) voting members appointed by the Board of Supervisors
 - Two (2) members nominated by the local chapter of the Society of Professional Journalists; one (1) shall be an attorney and one (1) shall be a journalist.
 - One (1) member shall be a member from the press or electronic media.
 - One (1) member shall be a journalist from a racial/ethnic-minority-owned news organization and nominated by New California Media.
 - One (1) member nominated by the local chapter of the League of Women Voters.
 - Two (2) members of the public experienced in consumer advocacy.
 - Four (4) members of the public who have demonstrated interest in, or have experience in,

the issues of citizen access and participation in local government.

- > One (1) member shall be the Mayor, or his/her designee, and serve as a non-voting member.
- > One (1) member shall be the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors, or his/her designee, and serve as a non-voting member.

At all times, the Task Force shall include at least one member who shall be a member of the public who is physically handicapped. All members must have experience and/or demonstrated interest in the issues of citizen access and participation in local government. The City Attorney's Office shall assign an attorney to the Task Force who is experienced in public-access law matters and serve as a legal advisor and advocate to the Task Force.

The term of each appointed member shall be two years unless removed by the Board of Supervisors. In the event of such removal or vacancy during the term of office of any appointive member, a successor shall be appointed for the unexpired term of the office vacated.

In addition to regular Task Force meetings, Task Force members are expected to participate in committee work.

Reports: The Task Force shall report annually to the Board of Supervisors on any practical or policy problems encountered in the Administration of the Ordinance. The Task Force shall, as it sees fit, issue public reports evaluating compliance with the Ordinance and related California laws by the City or any department, office or official.
