amendment for Contract No. 1000014465 for the Young Community Developers – Black
to the Future Program between the Young Community Developers and the City and
County of San Francisco, acting by and through its Department of Children, Youth and
Their Families; retroactively approving Amendment No. 1 to increase the grant
agreement amount by \$9,349,100 for a total not to exceed amount of \$11,491,745 and
extending the term agreement to June 30, 2023; and approving Amendment No. 2 to
increase the grant agreement amount by \$3,117,448 for a total not to exceed amount of
\$14,609,193 and extending the term agreement to June 30, 2024, for a total term of July
1, 2019, through June 30, 2024.
WHEREAS, The Young Community Developers – Black to the Future Program
provides intensive wraparound services to high-risk, multiple system involved youth age 14-24
and their families; and
WHEREAS, Black to the Future serves more than 165 San Francisco youth annually;
and
WHEREAS, The Black to the Future Program fulfills the Collaborative Funding Strategy
of the Department of Children, Youth and Their Families' (DCYF) Family Empowerment
Service Area, as described in the department's Request for Proposals issued August 18,
2017; and
WHEREAS, In conjunction with DCYF's Justice Service strategy, DCYF's Family
Empowerment Service Area offers services to all high-risk, multiple-system-involved youth in

1	WHEREAS, The Department of Children, Youth and Their Families entered into a grant
2	agreement with the Young Community Developers effective July 1, 2019, to June 30, 2020,
3	with a not to exceed amount of \$2,142,645; and
4	WHEREAS, The Department of Children, Youth and Their Families amended the
5	original grant agreement on January 6, 2020, to increase the grant amount by \$9,349,100 for
6	a revised not to exceed amount of \$11,491,745 and to extend the grant term to June 30,
7	2023; and
8	WHEREAS, The Department of Children, Youth and Their Families reported to the
9	Budget & Finance Committee of the Board of Supervisors, in a hearing on October 27, 2021,
10	on Board File No. 210960, the need to seek this retroactive approval; and
11	WHEREAS, The Department of Children, Youth and Their Families wishes to enter into
12	a second amendment to the grant agreement with the Young Community Developers to
13	further increase the grant amount by \$3,117,448 for a revised not to exceed amount of
14	\$14,609,193 and to extend the grant term to June 30, 2024; now, therefore, be it
15	RESOLVED, That the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the first and second
16	amendments to the grant agreement between the City and County of San Francisco and the
17	Young Community Developers to support the Black to the Future program during the period of
18	July 1, 2019, to June 30, 2024, for a total not to exceed amount of \$14,609,193; and, be it
19	FURTHER RESOLVED, That within thirty (30) days of the modification being fully
20	executed by all parties, the Department of Children, Youth and Their Families shall provide
21	the final grant agreement to the Clerk of the Board for inclusion into the official file.
