

1 [Mayoral Appointment, Redevelopment Successor Agency Oversight Board - Timothy Kojo
2 Minta]

3 **Motion approving/rejecting the mayoral nomination for appointment of Timothy Kojo**
4 **Minta to the Redevelopment Successor Agency Oversight Board (commonly known as**
5 **the Commission on Community Investment and Infrastructure), term ending January**
6 **24, 2024.**

8 WHEREAS, ABX1 26 was passed by the California State Legislature and signed by
9 Governor Jerry Brown in June 2011, and was largely upheld by the California Supreme Court
10 in *California Redevelopment Association v. Matosantos*, -- P.3d --, 12 Cal. Daily Op. Serv. 32
11 (Dec. 29, 2011); and

12 WHEREAS, That legislation established an Oversight Board responsible for the fiscal
13 management of the assets of the former City and County of San Francisco Redevelopment
14 Agency, other than affordable housing assets designated to it under California Health and
15 Public Safe Code sections 34180 and 34181; and

16 WHEREAS, State law requires the Redevelopment Successor Agency Oversight Board
17 to be composed of seven members selected as follows: three members appointed by the
18 Mayor and subject to confirmation by the Board of Supervisors; one member appointed by the
19 Bay Area Rapid Transit District, the largest special district, by property tax share, with territory
20 in the territorial jurisdiction of the former Redevelopment Agency; one member appointed by
21 the County Superintendent of Education to represent schools; one member appointed by the
22 Chancellor of the California Community Colleges to represent community college districts; and
23 one member appointed by the Mayor and subject to confirmation by the Board of Supervisors
24 to represent the largest number of employees currently employed by the former
25 Redevelopment Agency; and

1 WHEREAS, Redevelopment Successor Agency Oversight Board members serve at the
2 pleasure of the appointing body or individual; and

3 WHEREAS, Under California Health and Safety Code Section 34179, any individual
4 may serve on the Oversight Board at the same time as holding an office of the City and
5 County of San Francisco; and

6 WHEREAS, The Mayor has appointed Timothy Kojo Minta to the Redevelopment
7 Successor Agency Oversight Board, and has submitted the nomination to the Board of
8 Supervisors for confirmation, as required by State law; and

9 WHEREAS, The members of the Oversight Board appointed by the Mayor and subject
10 to confirmation by the Board of Supervisors shall serve at the pleasure of the Mayor for a term
11 of four years; provided, however, the Mayor shall designate two initial appointees to serve a
12 two-year term, and all subsequent terms shall be four years; now, therefore, be it

13 MOVED, That the Board of Supervisors of the City and County of San Francisco does
14 hereby approves/reject the Mayor’s nomination for appointment of Timothy Kojo Minta, for a
15 term ending January 24, 2024.
