SUBJECT: Mobile Probation Service Centers Grant Accept and Expend Retroactive Language

The department requests a Retroactive Accept and Expend for the Mobile Probation Service Centers Grant. The Mobile Probation Service Centers Grant is a new state grant. The application process was short due to the holidays with approximately three weeks to apply. Legislation development occurred shortly after award notification during budget season. Here is the timeline:

- On November 22, 2022, The Board of State and Community Corrections (BSCC) released the funding notification for this new grant.
- Adult Probation submitted the application on the January 6, 2023 due date.
- On April 14, 2023, the BSCC notified Adult Probation Department of the award.
- On May 10, 2023, the department began working with the Controller's Office on the legislation.
- July 17, 2023, legislation finalized.
