

1 [Public Auction - Tax-Defaulted Real Property]

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3 **Resolution authorizing Tax Collector to sell at public auction certain parcels of tax-**
4 **defaulted real property, as defined herein.**

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6 WHEREAS, The San Francisco Tax Collector has complied with all the statutory
7 prerequisites for selling tax-defaulted property at internet auction, and each of the parcels of
8 real property listed on the attached list of Tax-Defaulted Property Subject to Impending Tax
9 Sale has been duly entered on the Tax Collector’s roll of tax-defaulted real property for longer
10 than 5 years; and

11 WHEREAS, The San Francisco Tax Collector shall research the physical
12 characteristics and ownership history for each parcel on the attached list using property
13 information available from the Assessor and the Planning Department; and

14 WHEREAS, The San Francisco Tax Collector shall expend additional resources to
15 identify and notify parties of interest for any parcel on the auction list, including skip tracing
16 which typically involves a search of publicly available and proprietary databases, city/county
17 and other governmental records, and the internet, used by our collections staff to recover
18 delinquent obligations to the City; and

19 WHEREAS, The Tax Collector shall post a physical notice on any occupied parcel, and
20 on any physically accessible vacant parcel for whom the certified mail to the owner is
21 returned; and

22 WHEREAS, To bring additional resources to taxpayers at risk of losing their properties
23 to tax auction, the Tax Collector has referred eight parcels to Homeownership SF, eight
24 parcels to the Mayor’s Office of Housing and Community Development, seven parcels to the
25 Sheriff’s Office, six parcels to the Department of Building Inspection, three parcels to Adult

1 Protective Services, two parcels to the Assessor, two parcels to the Public Utilities
2 Commission, two parcels to the Public Administrator, two parcels to the San Francisco
3 Housing Development Corporation, and one parcel to the Rent Board; now, therefore, be it

4 RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Tax Collector is hereby directed to advertise and
5 sell each of the parcels listed on the attached List of Tax-Defaulted Property Subject to
6 Impending Tax Sale in the manner provided by the California Revenue and Taxation Code in
7 Division I, Part 6, including but not limited to the minimum bid procedures authorized by
8 Section 3698.6(c); and the Tax Collector is further directed to add the cost of advertisement
9 and sale of the herein described property to the minimum price to be collected from the
10 parcels offered for tax sale; and, be it

11 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Tax Collector is authorized to sell all
12 properties listed on the attached List of Tax-Defaulted Property Subject to Impending Tax
13 Sale below the minimum bid amount, if such properties cannot first be sold at the minimum
14 bid amount proposed at the sale; and, be it

15 FURTHER RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Tax Collector is authorized to notify
16 any new parties of interest in accordance with Section 3701 and reoffer any parcel that
17 remains unsold within 90 days.

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
