[Recount of November 6, 2001 Election.]

Resolution urging the California Secretary of State to use its authority under California Government Code Section 12172.5 to conduct a full and public recount of the November 6, 2001 San Francisco Municipal election.

WHEREAS, There are reported errors in the safekeeping, handling, tallying, counting, recording or certification of the ballots or votes cast at the November 6, 2001 San Francisco Municipal election; and,

WHEREAS, These errors make it sufficiently likely that the result of the November 6, 2001 San Francisco Municipal election was affected as to the successful candidates or propositions, or sufficient to cast substantial doubt on the accuracy of the results of the November 7, 2000 San Francisco Municipal election; and,

WHEREAS, California Government Code Section 12172.5 states, "The Secretary of State is the chief elections officer of the state, and shall administer the provisions of the Elections Code"; and,

WHEREAS, That under California Government Code Section 12172.5, the Secretary of State, in order to determine whether an elections law violation has occurred, may examine voted, unvoted, spoiled, and canceled ballots, vote-counting computer programs, absent voter envelopes and applications, and other elections related materials; therefore, be it,

RESOLVED, That the San Francisco Board of Supervisors urges the California Secretary of State to conduct a full and public recount of the November 6, 2001 San Francisco Municipal election; and, be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, That the clerk of the Board of Supervisors shall send a copy of this resolution to the Governor, California Secretary of State, and the San Francisco representatives in the Assembly and California Senate.
